### Relevent Employment and Experience

Freelance Videographer - (August)

During the month of August I had the joy of working with LMSUK and Vaudeville Cherry Gin. Having worked alongside LMS before it was a joy to return to action with them. This time filming social media content for their music networking event. Shortly after this I was approached by Vaudeville to attent Victorious Festival and gather content for their brand. This was my first experience of filming at such a large event, the busy nature of their stall provided some great content that Vaudeville are now using to promote their brand.

Paleo Ridge - Video Content Producer (May to August)
My role within the Sales and Marketing department involved bringing the selling points of the brand to the fore through video marketing. I was the account holder for the company's YouTube and TikTok accounts, as well as creating video content for their Instagram account and other forms of social media including Twitter and LinkedIn. Skills developed during this employment include digital marketing, manipulating social media algorithms for optimum branding placement, producing short form video content, along with developing my understanding of how to produce informative yet engaging advertising campaigns. I also played an integral part in campaign planning and management. I look forward to continuing my work with Paleo on a freelance basis to continue to create adverts with them.

Freelance Editor - TRAP, short film (September 2021 - November 2021) TRAP is a film produced by People of our World Media following a young person's affiliation with gang culture. As Editor I worked closely with the Director to ensure that the best of the script and footage was obtained to create a visceral and captivating story.

Freelance Videographer and Editor - Sunshine Sisters Showreel (May 2021) The Sunshine sisters are singers based in Portsmouth. I captured footage and audio of the duo performing their upcoming set as a marketing campaign to raise their profile.

Producer - Holy Grail (September 2020 - May 2021)

Award winning short film Holy Grail is a dark comedy centred around the relationship two men have with one another while caught in a hard cycle of drug addiction. As a small team we were able to successfully crowdfund and work collaboratively under the pressures of the pandemic. We filmed at varying locations including a dive pool which gave me the opportunity to use my qualification as a film and media diver. As Producer my role involved sourcing actors, locations, additional team members and hospitality for the cast and crew. I also managed contracts, shoot plans, budgeting, the films website and social media. I was the point of contact for all team members and supported problem solving throughout production.

Freelance Editor - DROP, short film (November 2020 - January 2021) DROP is a short film which looks into the mind of a man struggling with his mental health on the brink of breaking point. The film went on to be featured on the Mental Health Week website and received multiple awards. As the films Editor I was able to visually show the struggle of the lead character whilst ensuring the flow of the story and remaining sympathetic to the subject matter.

Sound Design - Home, an experimental documentary (January 2019 - May 2019) This documentary focussed on three different people's experience with moving to a new city, their connection with home and what home means to them. As a small team we worked together to source a variety of young people with different experiences and opinions to create an engaging and warm documentary. I used sound design to demonstrate the claustrophobia felt by one of our clients as she transitioned from a village to a busy city in order to 'show' rather than 'tell' her feelings.

Bar Manager - Becketts Southsea Restaurant (October 2018 - May 2022) As part of the management team at this multi-award winning restaurant, my responsibilities included management of staff, rota's, stock, menus and customer service. This position has developed transferable skills in communication, leadership, teamwork, negotiation, management of self within a sometimes stressful environment, mentorship and delivering training. I can also make a cracking cocktail!
